

Low Maintenance Grass Mat



For extensive green roofs requiring a turf grass finish with low maintenance

An attractive slow growing fine turf requiring minimum maintenance. The Low Maintenance Grass Mat comprises an established mixture of slow growing grasses in a felt mat. The Low Maintenance Grass is drought tolerant and disease resistant. It prefers low fertility and therefore needs less water, fungicide and fewer fertiliser inputs.

Mixture:	Crested Hairgrass: slow growing and drought tolerant, prefers dry, low fertility situations. Hard Fescue: drought tolerant fescue with low maintenance requirements. Slender Creeping Red Fescue: some drought tolerance with a low maintenance requirement.
Substrate:	Axter Hydrosol extensive lightweight green roof substrate at a depth of min.100-125mm.
Installation:	The mats are available in 1m x 2m rolls for easy installation. Sustainably grown in the UK, they are freshly harvested and rapidly transported to your roof meaning less stress on your plants and better establishment.
Maintenance:	The grass can be left unmown until autumn when it will have achieved a height of about 200mm. It should then be mown and the clippings removed. This grass mat will flower in late May/early June producing decorative seed heads. Flowering can be avoided by mowing once in late spring.
