

Wildflower and Meadow Grass Mat

A mix of taller growing native wildflowers and grasses in a moisture retentive, biodegradable felt mat to produce the effect of a wildflower meadow on a roof



The mixture in the wildflower and meadow grass mat complements the local habitat or replaces habitat lost by the footprint of the building.

<p>Mixture:</p>	<p>Included in the mat is a mixture of non-aggressive meadow grasses mixed with twenty species of drought tolerant native wildflowers including:</p> <p>Cowslip, Meadow Buttercup, Lady's Bedstraw, Self Heal, Red Campion, Yellow Rattle and Yarrow. The flowering period is prolonged, from April until September, which provides an aesthetic appeal as well as habitat for insects, birds and butterflies.</p> <p>The height of plants when flowering is 40-60 cm. The percentage of grasses will vary according to substrate depth and amount of natural rainfall.</p>
<p>Substrate:</p>	<p>Axter Hydrosol extensive lightweight green roof substrate at a minimum recommended depth of 100mm.</p>
<p>Installation:</p>	<p>The mat is available in 0.6m x 2.0m (1.2m²) or 1.2m x 2.0m (2.4m²) rolls for easy installation and to suit site requirements. Sustainably grown in the UK, they are freshly harvested and rapidly transported to your roof meaning less stress on plants and better establishment.</p>
<p>Maintenance:</p>	<p>The plants need a full cut in late autumn. All cuttings should be removed. A spring cut may be required if the grasses become too dominant.</p>
